In this stylish black comedy, an attractive, but thoroughly eccentric couple who live in a model home of an abandoned housing development come under the special gaze of director Atom Egoyan (*Speaking Parts*, *Family Viewing*). He is an insurance adjuster who yearns for the comforts he so easily and generously gives his clients; she is a government censor who secretly tapes the pornographic films she classifies. This twisted couple becomes linked to a lusty pair who like to stage their sexual fantasies in elaborate and eventually violent acts. Egoyan's work gets stronger and more confident as he adds more layers to his vision.
